**Subject**: N.J.A.C 2:90 – 1 et seq. Rules Adoption

The adopted amendments to the Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Act Rules, N.J.A.C. 2:90-1 et seq., will appear in the **January 21, 2014** New Jersey Register. To allow districts and the regulated community adequate opportunity to adjust to changes to the Standards for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control, an administrative correction will be provided in the **February 3<sup>rd</sup>** Register, deferring the **effective date** for these amendments to **February 20, 2014**.

All Standards will be available on the New Jersey Department of Agriculture website (<a href="http://www.state.nj.us/agriculture/divisions/anr/nrc/njerosion.html">http://www.state.nj.us/agriculture/divisions/anr/nrc/njerosion.html</a>) and will no longer be printed by this office.

As a point of clarification, proposed amendments to the Standard for Topsoiling and the Standard for Land Grading were not adopted, therefore, the **July 1999** version of those Standards remain in effect pending future changes pursuant to the Soil Restoration Act, P.L.2010, c.113.

Soil Conservation Districts are requested to make this information available on their local websites and provide outreach to their municipalities as well as professional engineers and builders in their area.
