Charting the Course

The names of places are a very integral part of an understanding and appreciation of an area. Historically, the names we give places can give a perspective on how people viewed or utilized the unique features of an area.

Vocabulary

Specific town and community names.

- Maps of Ocean County and Barnegat Bay watershed for each group.

Making Connections

Knowing the connections between the names of places and the natural resources around them, the land, the water and the historical use or feature, can often provide a clearer sense of connection to students. Often, places have been named based on some unique feature, person, or natural phenomenon. For example, Swan Point is a place where swans often congregate and is a place where the land juts out into the bay. There are numerous examples of this throughout Ocean County and our watershed. Understanding these connections will help connect students to the places within their watershed.

Procedure

WARM UP: Ask the class if they know any places that are named after a physical feature of that particular place. Island Beach is a simple example, Seaside is another, for the northern watershed residents. Long Beach Island is very familiar to the southern watershed residents. Places are also named based on simple connections to place. Many places are named for the people that first settled there or made a significant contribution to the area. Another factor is the abundance of Native American names within Ocean County. Significant information and research is available on this topic. Please see the additional resources listed below or contact your local historical society. They are listed in the resource guide.

Divide the students into groups of four or five Distribute the copies of the handout of Ocean County names, and the maps.

Have students work together to find as many places on the maps in the time you've allowed. If the maps have been laminated, students can use small, removable dot stickers or a grease pencil to mark their locations on the map.

These could be numbered to correspond with the numbers on the place name list.

This could be done as a competition among groups to see which group can locate the most places in a set amount of time.

WRAP UP: Have each student choose a different place and have him or her write a description of why they think that name was chosen. Have the groups share with the rest of the class.

Have students share the names of their neighborhoods with the rest of the class. What are they named after? For example, Sandy Point, Brick, is named after the small river beach on the Metedeconk River that was a large point or spit of sand. Swan Point is named for the usual congregation of swans there in the winter months.

Ocean County Community names have changed over time. Old maps, newspaper articles, histories, and laws of New Jersey often contain place names which are no longer being used. These names sometimes cause confusion in understanding boundary descriptions and maps. Listed here are names which are not a part of present day Ocean County along with the corresponding current name of the same place. Communities are listed in alphabetical order.

So...what's in a name? Take a look!

The information below was taken from **"The Lure of Long Beach, The Story of the Romantic** *Island of Long Beach, New Jersey,"* by Charles Edgar Nash, published in 1936 in conjunction with the Long Beach Board of Trade. **See Dutch map on next page.*

The Dutch explorers set foot on Long Beach in the early 1600s and called the region "Eyerhaven." which meant "Harbor of the Eggs." It was later changed to "Egg Harbor."

They gave the area this name due to the amazing amount of seabird eggs they found in the region.

They also named two inlets, "Barendegat," – inlet of breakers. A mapmaker later shortened the name to "Barndegat." And perhaps he just made a typesetting mistake. Today, "Barnegat" Inlet still retains the name... and the breakers!
